Fertilizer Values for 2013 (AES13E-1)

This external policy establishes values for fertilizer in accordance with Section 76-11-9 NMSA 1978 to be used in determining and assessing penalties in accordance with Section 76-11-8 NMSA 1978. This policy supersedes AES11E-1.

The New Mexico Department of Agriculture has determined and hereby publishes the following commercial fertilizer values for 2013.

- a. Total Nitrogen (N) \$0.95 per pound or \$19.00 per unit* of plant food
- b. Available Phosphoric Acid (P₂O₅) \$1.15 per pound or \$23.00
- c. Soluble Potash (K_2O) \$0.85 per pound or \$17.00 per unit* of plant food

^{*}A unit of plant food is 20 pounds or 1 percent of a ton.
