Pesticide Applicator Renewal

- We will begin mailing out 2025 license renewal forms the first week of November. If you do not receive your form by mid-November, request a form via email to <u>pesticides@nmda.nmsu.edu</u> or call 575-646-2134.
- Completion of a CEU course **DOES NOT** renew your license automatically.
- To Renew:
 - Renewal forms must be signed and returned to NMDA.
 - Renewal forms can be sent to NMDA via mail or email.
 - Forms sent via mail must be accompanied by a check or money order for the appropriate amount <u>for those licenses that require a fee</u>.
 - Forms sent via email must request an invoice to pay online.
 - Public Applicators are exempt from a fee but <u>MUST</u> return a signed renewal form.
 - Commercial Applicators must submit current insurance certificates with their renewals.
 - Commercial Applicators must renew their license before their Operator/Technicians.

Note: Private Applicators need 5 CEUs, Public, Commercial & Non-Commercial Applicators need 4 CEUs by 12/31/24
