Proclamation

WHEREAS, the enhancement of trade relations and the development of new trade agreements are vital for the continued growth and success of New Mexico's agricultural sector; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative to raise awareness among consumers, businesses, and policymakers about the challenges and opportunities facing agricultural trade; and

WHEREAS, all residents, businesses, educational institutions and governmental entities are encouraged to recognize and participate in this observance, contributing to the advancement and understanding of the agricultural trade's significant role in supporting economic development and innovation in our state.
