2024 Special Hemp Breeding License Application



The Special Hemp Breeding License is intended for qualified plant breeders that will be breeding for new or improved varieties of hemp and may possess viable plants or plant material in excess of three tenths (0.3%) and less than five (5.0%) total THC (delta-9tetrahydrocannabinol +THCA). Plants covered under this license shall only be grown in a secure indoor location (greenhouse, warehouse). Forms can be completed electronically before printing, or printed and completed manually before mailing. Do not include payment with your application. Your application will be reviewed and you will be notified of its approval or rejection. If your application is approved, you will be required to submit payment prior to issuance of a license. Applications that contain errors or are illegible will be returned for corrections. Licenses issued under this application will expire January 31, 2025.
